Coaching Wins

Current Projects

- Preferred Vendor List: We are assembling an internal reference for all vendors we refer students

- Al Sorted Q&A Recordings: We are testing several different programs which use Al to automatically caption and segment Q&A recordings into chapters and topics. This will make it far, far easier for students to use past recordings to research answers to their burning questions!
- Al Translation Lesson: Several of our coaches are helping Product out by doing the legwork and initial scripting for a lesson on translating your book into other languages, using Al as a fast and cheap helper.
- Contact & Re-engagement Plan: We need a snazzier name for this. Nicole has worked her up a sweat detailing out a comprehensive plan for how we will pro-actively contact students from day 1 to day 180. All designed to increase activity rates and ensure students have every possible chance to succeed.
