- Kayla Bringing home to Work Hard, Stay Humble Core Value award!




Q2 Focus

The coaching team has three key areas of focus as we head into the second quarter. These MITs are all designed to drive the department forward in our mission to provide amazing coaching that leads the most possible students towards a successful career in self-publishing.

The first is our eternal quest to perfect the quality & consistency of coaching. To work towards this goal we are building a coach and supervisor facing KPI dashboard, building out tracking of quality metrics in hubspot, and expanding our internal training program.

The second is to significantly improve the PA success rate. What is that? Simply, it's the percentage of students who make it all the way through to publish a money-making book. This is a year long goal with many milestones. One of the key ones for Q2 is to vastly increase the number of students who get on a first call. In January the percentage of new PA students who booked a call within their first 30 days was under 20%. We've almost doubled that since, and our goal is to exceed 50% by the end of the quarter.

Our last MIT is to take a comprehensive survey of our tech tools to identify and eliminate problems in our tech stack. This is to ensure a positive student experience, and to remove inefficiencies and roadblocks for our staff. We'll be connecting with many other departments as we work through issues, and I expect us to be Shahmir's best friend by the time we're done.
