- We kicked off our "Road to 1k Trustpilot" reviews project. The goal is simple, get our Trustpilot reviews from 960 over the 1k mark and we've seen amazing progress at 988 reviews. Just 12 more to go. Way to go team!
- We kicked off our AIA refund saves project. It has been a great
 preview of a potential phone support system as well as getting a
 direct line to connect with students leaving the program. While
 we look forward to our first save, the insight we have received
 from these calls are priceless. Shout-out to every member of the
 team pounding the phone lines and putting the minutes in. Big
 shout to Pete for getting this project into our pipeline and signing
 off on every stage, and Mark Tandan for crafting an impeccable
 script for us.
- Failed payments are finally automated! Thanks to the Tech team.
 Now, potential students who try to join the course and fail, will receive an auto email letting them know how to retry their enrollment. This has simplified our follow-up system and freed-up time for us to work on other tasks.
- We are automating the 7DPC fulfilment Early in the month, we lost access to our Amazon account we use to buy and send 7DPC books to students. Thankfully, we have secured a potential partnership with ZincAPI who will be automating this process using their managed account. With this, we can fulfil higher book volumes at great speeds.
- Thanks to the tech team, our DFY book topic form has a new home. We have successfully transitioned all our student-facing forms out of typeform and into hubspot.



Lots of exciting things are going on in Coaching! Here are a few of the big highlights:

- We have been busy for the last two weeks getting coaches geared up for the arrival of our Al overlords. I cannot tell you how proud I am of this team but I'm going to try.
- The entire coaching team contributed to a massive fact-finding project. Each coach was assigned a focus area to dive into, giving everyone the opportunity to learn via hands-on discovery. To a man (or woman) our coaches rocked the research step.
- Ed rode shotgun to make sure the content delivered was accurate. Cody took the sum of everyone's research and turned it into an epic team-wide training.
- Kris is working on individual lessons that deep-dive into each major category of AI knowledge. Nicole has been coordinating projects and ensuring things get done on time. And Kelli is proctoring a number of live role-play scenarios to get coaches reps with AI questions, so they're ready for the big time when our tool arrives for students.
- The hard work is already seeing early fruit we have students asking about using ChatGPT every day, and now coaches have the foundation to answer those questions and explore new ones!
- This has been a massive team effort, and I'm just so happy to share how everyone contribute to an outstanding result. A lot of what we've learned will change in the coming weeks or months. Some of the things we're telling coaches now will be tweaked to match anything Rasmus produces, and the peculiarities of our own software solution. The big idea here was to lay a strong foundation in practical use of modern Al tools, and the team crushed it.
