

There are many students on this call, all at different points in their publishing journey. We receive many questions and do our best to choose the ones that are applicable and helpful to the majority of attendees on this call.


We would rather spend more time going deep into a good question rather than rushing from one question to the next. Therefore, we will pick and choose the best questions.

"Hello! Is there someone who can help me refine my topic a bit more? Once I got to the Topic Research Sheet, my mind split in 2 directions, and I have been down the rabbit hole in both directions, researching as the modules progressed. The two directions are 1) Women in leadership and 2) Intuitive Development or Spiritual growth.

For background, I have written 4 books on spiritual growth, energy healing, and personal growth. I have a book title that comes from a keynote that I have done, and my market test of that keynote was very positive. Yet the book could be for either women leaders (not just in business) or on developing intuition. Both PoCs came out positive for both directions.
