



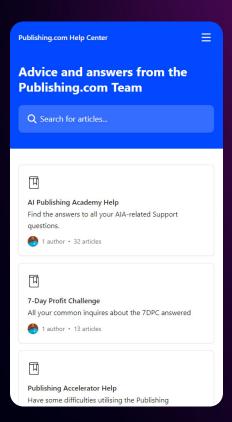

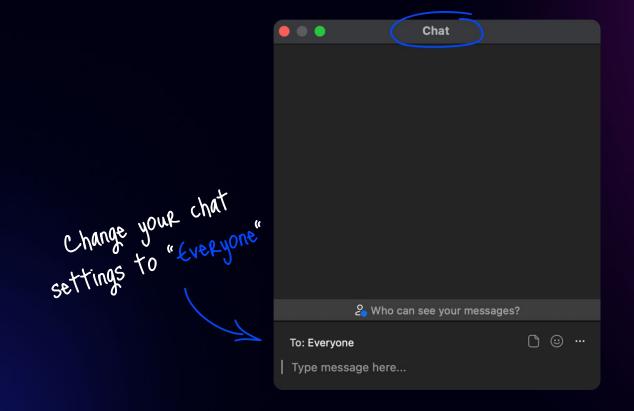

1st one is my natural version

1.As every know what's is kids entrepreneurs, I don't want to detail it a lot. In my experience I have seen most of the kids are creative in nature and experiment a lot. If you have notice a 3 year old faced with a problem they naturally tend to find solutions to their problem. For example, when a child wants switch on the light, they first stand and try to touch the light button, once that's failed they put some pillows or any object they can climb to touch the light button, if they fall by that object again try to something stronger and tall enough to touch the light button and finally they switch on the light. You could notice these same gestures exhibited in different situation in young children. Naturally they have these skills of Creativity, Problem solving and Resilience. 2.Most children have an innate nature of being creative and wanting to experiment. Watch any three-year-old who has a problem set before them. Observe them as they naturally attempt to figure out a problem. Consider what happens when a toddler wants to turn on the light. They first try reaching up, and it's just a bit too high. So they pile up pillows or climb onto a chair. And when that doesn't work, they look for something sturdier. Until, of course, they do-through trial and error and sheer persistence.

It is this inborn ability to think creatively, solve problems, and show resilience that is the bedrock of an entrepreneurial mindset. But over time, these skills fade-but not because the potential is lost, simply because it hasn't been nurtured. The good news? We can re-ignite and strengthen these abilities with the right approach.
