

There are many students on this call, all at different points in their publishing journey. We receive many questions and do our best to choose the ones that are applicable and helpful to the majority of attendees on this call.


We would rather spend more time going deep into a good question rather than rushing from one question to the next. Therefore, we will pick and choose the best questions.

"Hi Coaches!

I'm having a real hard time with the editing part of the manuscript because after the first round of inline editing, I still found several basic editing oversights (improper capitalization, extra or missing spaces, forgotten words, etc.) as well as big flow, structure and coherence problems.

I've expressed my concerns to the editor a couple of times and he assures me he ""will personally go through the entire book again"" (wasn't he supposed to do this the first time around?). I feel like I wasted my money hiring an inline editor as I'm still spending a lot of time fixing these errors anyway. I am waiting for him to go over the book again but then I'll have to go over it all again myself. What would you suggest I do at this point?
