

We would rather spend more time going deep into a good question rather than rushing from one question to the next. Therefore, we will pick and choose the best questions.







I have a question regarding the SEO mechanism, which you briefly explained last week. When it comes to optimizing keywords for SEO on Amazon, does the exact placement of the keyword within the title matter, or will Amazon's search algorithm recognize it as long as it's somewhere in the title?

For instance, let's consider two hypothetical (main) titles with "ChatGPT" as the keyword here: "Beginner's Guide to ChatGPT" and "How to Make Money with ChatGPT." Would these titles be sufficient for SEO purposes, or should I consider moving the keyword to the front, such as "ChatGPT, The Beginner's Guide" or "ChatGPT, How to Make Money with It," in order to maximize SEO?

Title: Intermittent Fasting for Women over 50



Just as a bit of background, the top 5 sellers all have 'Lose Weight' in their sub-title, but I don't think that paints a picture of the end result, whereas 'Get Slim' imho does. They also have 'Regain Energy' or 'Boost Energy', so I added 'Lost', again to try and paint a picture of how potential buyers used to be. 2 others say 'Delay Aging', I've gone for 'Boost Longevity' instead. No-one else mentions calorie counting or it being free to practice. All of the 5 mention meal plans in the title, hence why I do. I could have just had a sticker on the cover, as previously advised, but I think I will have both. Thanks in advance.



Creating Your Book Title

Part 1: Main Title

Part 2: Subtitle






Part 1: Creating The Main Title

Key Elements

- The main keyword (book topic) must be in the main title
- It must be crystal clear what the book is about
- Should be different from other books already published






Part 2: Creating The Subtitle

Key Elements



Related keywords (2-5): What words are people searching to find a book about your topic?

- Benefits (3): What your reader WANTS to achieve by buying your book (desired outcomes)
- Copywriting: Beef up your book title with more appealing word choice and promises





How To Know If Your Title Is 💫

Main title

- Does it contain the book topic AKA the main keyword?
- Are there already multiple books with the exact same main title?
 - o 1-2 is ok, but there shouldn't be more than that

Subtitle

- ✓ Does it contain the 2-5 most important related keywords?
- Are the benefits clear & meaningful to the target audience?
- Is it grammatically perfect?
- Does it flow nicely? (not a run-on, keyword stuffed sentence)
- Is it compelling? (attractive word choice, speed, ease, etc.)
