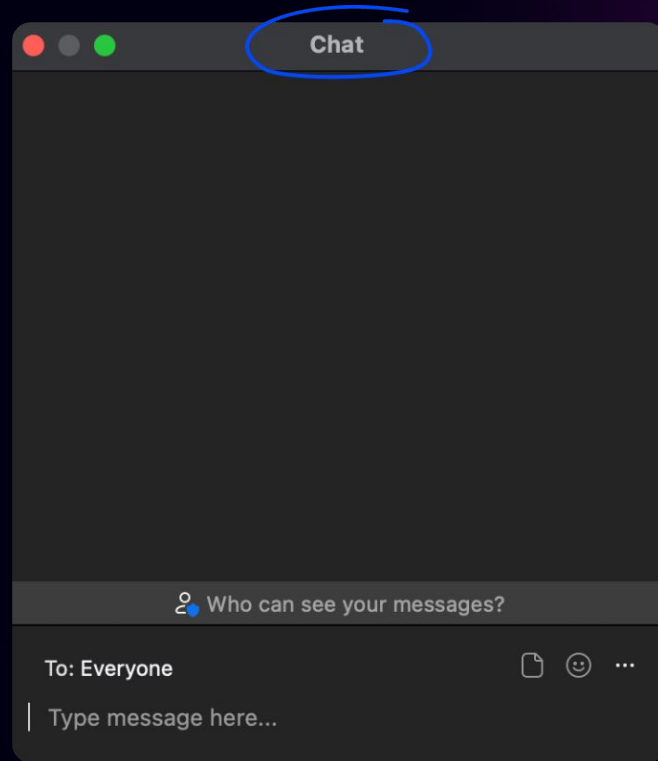

Good morning. I have a question. I published my book in July 2024, but it hasn't sold many copies. Through Pubby, I have 53 excellent reviews, and I am consistently on the best-sellers list in the childcare category, sometimes ranking #32, other times #60 or #73. I focused on creating a bundle, and as of today, I have two more manuscripts, making it a three-book series. All three books have at least a 4-star rating in POC.

I tried promoting my book through Amazon and Facebook ads, but they did not work for me, possibly due to my lack of expertise. While I am editing my two manuscripts, I wanted to ask: should I try putting my book on IngramSpark, or should I consider changing the cover first?
