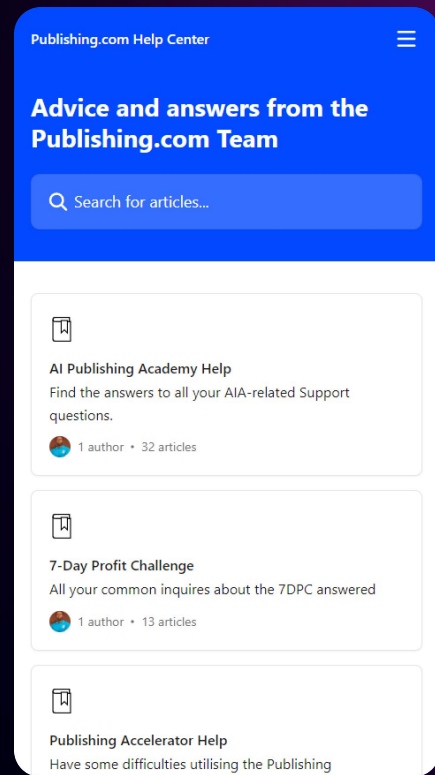

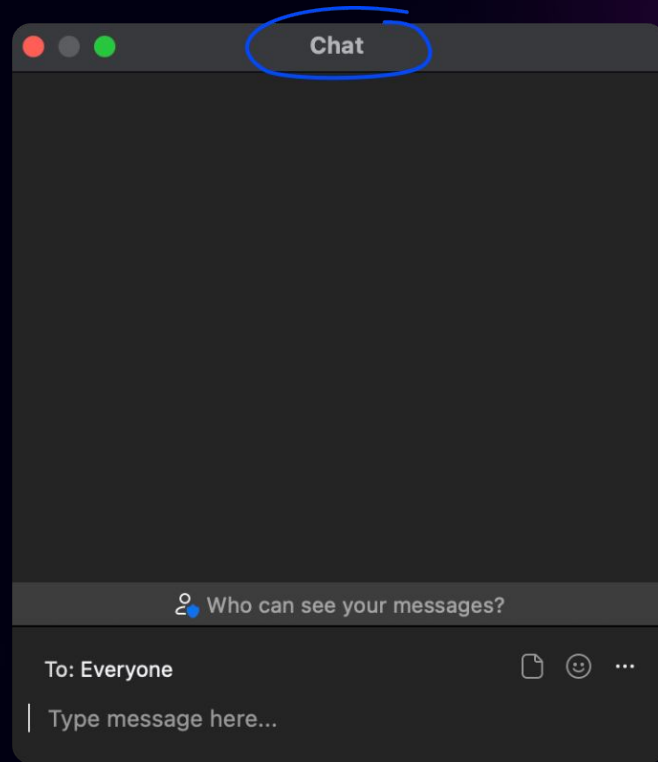

2. At least 3 books bringing in more than \$500 monthly revenue
3. Market saturation and uniqueness of the topic"
