

We would rather spend more time going deep into a good question rather than rushing from one question to the next. Therefore, we will pick and choose the best questions.







Hi. I'm about to start sending out copies of my manuscript for people to read so they can leave reviews once it goes live on Amazon. I believe it is recommended to watermark the document so someone can't steal your manuscript. However, I haven't been able to find a lesson about that. Can you walk me through that process? Thanks.

I recall in the earlier lessons we were shown how to craft the direct review link to give to our readers. Can you please remind me where in the course I can find this? Also, does the updated course material provide information on how to access a universal link (where readers may get to the page without scrolling, irrespective of where they are located)?

Hi coaches, my 30K book is slowly reaching my publishing goal. With FB ads I had over 200+ emails, but barely any return response when I sent mailer lite campaign follow ups. I'm manually emailing to promote FREE pdf and getting few responses back.

I feel like all these emails I got are useless if no one actually responds back to tell me they want the book. I think I'll get better luck just using free promo days and using book promo site as an option. Any tips or advice?

Hi there! I apologize, I did already submit a question about this yesterday but I did some more research on 'Testimonials' I was able to find a website that is all about testimonials and success stories. I am just wondering if it is legal for me to use a website like that as a reference in my book?

I won't be able to be on the call, but will review Tuesday evening for the answer. I have received back my expanded outline from Publishing Services that I paid for, after being encouraged by the FB community to utilize them. However, I would say 85% of it is simply web links to articles... so like a bullet point, then 6-10 web links, another bullet point, then 6-10 web links. I wanted to know if this is normal, but more importantly if I send this on to a ghostwriter if they are going to freak out like I did just seeing pages of weblinks (58 pages!), or if they will use all these links themselves to flesh out my outline into prose.

Hi Coaches, I am having a very difficult time figuring out the KD SPY / Amazon interface. I have installed KD SPY on Chrome, & pinned it to the tool bar. I keep getting an oops error message when I try to put anything into the browser to check a topic for proof of concept. What is the exact procedure to get this work. On the modules it looks so fast and easy. When I try a different topic, it reloads KD Spy each time. This is time consuming. In addition, the bar I am entering the topic in is blocked by KD Spy. What exactly should I be searching in Amazon? I have tried whatever comes up and none of them work. I keep getting an oops error. I have been trying to get help on this mess for over a weeks. My book is on Gut health and my Ghostwriter is using phrases like, 'This is super important' which I find 'colloquial' rather than something I would expect to find in written English. (In the UK we wouldn't take a book seriously if we read that).

I have started to take them out, replacing them with phrases like, 'extremely important'., or 'very important'. The Publishing Services suggests using a 'cocktail party pitch' for the summary of the book but I'm just wondering what you think and whether a US readership would react differently? i.e. find it more 'normal' and perhaps 'engaging', easy to read.

David

For the author's background and reasons for writing part of my outline I included several family illnesses from our wider family circle (which may be Gut Health related-Book topic.) My Ghost Writer decided to write a 'testimonial' concerning my father, with a whole host of things wrong with him, (so many I'm not sure one person could have them). While I'm writing under a penname I did feel like it was a pack of lies and a bit OTT '(over the top) and wonder how I can get around it. Obviously if it sounds unreal for one person, then it needs tweaked.

- -However, attributing them to my rather, I feel very uncomfortable. Should I not worry since it's a penname? or suggest that we go with 'Uncle Bob' or a similar name, where it sounds made up, (but then that might not help the seriousness of the book)?
- -I had wondered about suggesting to the reader that they may have an 'Uncle Bob' or 'Aunt Betty' or 'cousin John', who has this, that and the other and has tried doing this and that with no success and who would like to know about the content of the book so that it's clear we are talking about a fictitious figure whose ailments could well reflect a relative of the reader.

When I have chosen the ghostwriter I want from writing samples, do I click DENY on the others? Seems harsh, but I guess the others need to know they weren't chosen.



Keywords: Words/terms used in the title that you want your book to show up for when someone searches it on Amazon or Audible.

- Main keyword Companion planting
- Related keywords Gardening, beginner's guide, plant health, harvest, garden

Benefits: What your reader WANTS to achieve by buying your book (desired outcomes).



Part 2: Subtitle






Part 1: Creating The Main Title

Key Elements

- The main keyword (book topic) must be in the main title
- It must be crystal clear what the book is about
- Should be different from other books already published






Part 2: Creating The Subtitle

Key Elements



Related keywords (2-5): What words are people searching to find a book about your topic?

- Benefits (3): What your reader WANTS to achieve by buying your book (desired outcomes)
- Copywriting: Beef up your book title with more appealing word choice and promises





How Long Should My Title Be?

- Character Limit = 200
- Recommended character count = 120 180
