

There are many students on this call, all at different points in their publishing journey. We receive many questions and do our best to choose the ones that are applicable and helpful to the majority of attendees on this call.


We would rather spend more time going deep into a good question rather than rushing from one question to the next. Therefore, we will pick and choose the best questions.

My first 30K book is set to Launch in 2 days. I've used Facebook ads, and the free facebook review method. I've joined 37 groups that are related to my niche. I've only been able to send out 60 free early copies of my book. I know it's recommended to have at least 200 reviewers with the expectation that only about half would respond and leave a review once it's released. I've asked the question on the AIA Facebook group and it was recommended to possibly delay the book launch, but i've just about exhausted all groups in my niche, and spent over a \$100 on Facebook Ads. I have also received AIA's Quality Stamp of Approval on my book. At this point, I'm thinking of just keeping my release date, signing onto Pubby, and hoping to get at least 15 Verified purchase reviews before I switch to Amazon Ads. So I guess I would like to know what your thoughts are, and what other advice do you have if any?

Hi coaches, thank you for all that you do. I have been running Amazon ads since October 1, 2023. I have 40 reviews and 15,000+ impressions, nothing to negative target yet. I have had 6 sales from ads and 5 organic sales. I noticed one of the Manual keywords and one of the Manual product which had sales on respective ad campaigns were high (x 4 of my break-even ACOS), so I reduced the bids by 5 cents on each. Since then (about a week ago), I haven't had any sales. Do I review the bid upward again? What else can I do to optimize my ads and get more sales?

Hi Coaches. Working on my first 30K book and writing in Reedsy. It doesn't seem to work the way it's shown in training. I know the recommended process is to hire a GW, but what if we want to write the book? I've submitted questions to Reedsy via chat, but am not getting answers to my questions e.g. how to delete a chapter or a part. Chapters are numbered in the editor, when you add a chapter, that number appears in the writing area and is not editable. You then add a chapter title, but that Reedsy number appears at the top and when you generate the print ready file and upload to KDP, that number appears in the print preview. How can I learn about how to use this? Can't find any tutorial. Please advise if you can?
