What font and formatting settings should you use on word and how to get your books translated into different languages.

Is it possible, or advisable, to publish an e-book before or instead of a hard copy?

#### **Dominique Decelles**

Here are the problems I'm having:

- 1) I can't change the size of the images in Reedsy which completely changes my layout and shifts the text which doesn't look good when I download the pdf.
- 2) On the ebook preview, the copyright and page content are missing. However, they are in the manuscript and also on the pdf for the paper book. Why?
- 3) As Reedsy is in English, some page titles are in English(Content, copyright, preface, dedication...) but my book is in French, which makes no sense.
- 4) When I try to fill in the progress form for day 6 another technical problem arises: I can't download it because it says my pdf is too big.

For me, quality and consistency are important. I don't want to publish a book Like that.

5) Another question I asked, for the price of the first book in the 7-day challenge, Rasmus suggests \$2.99 for the ebook and \$12.99 for the paper book since the book is supposed to be about 5000 words long but mine is over 12,000. Do I still put these amounts or am I better off raising the price a bit? Something like \$4.99 for the ebook and \$14.99 for the book.

#### **Cherie Johnston**


