

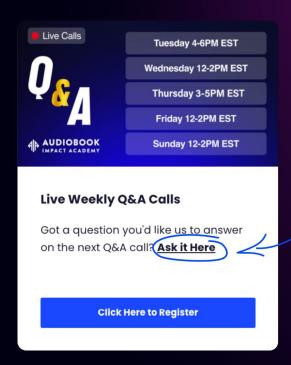

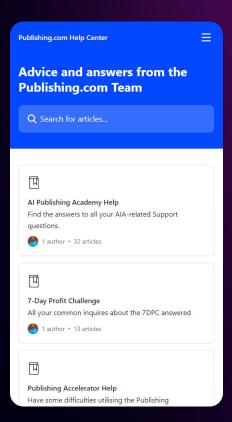

## David

I had asked this question in the Facebook group:

"Question about copywriting our books. I filed for the copyright for my book, but the person I am in contact with from the copyright office is asking me about the copyright for the book cover art and sent me this as what my options are:

- "(1) ARTIST RETAINS RIGHTS. In this case, the artist created the work for you and gave it to you, and you own the physical artwork/right to use the artwork, but copyright ownership still belongs to the creator.
- (2) TRANSFER. In this case, the artist signed away all copyright rights to you "by written agreement" or some other writing, such as 'by contract' or 'by assignment' etc. If so, then the artist would need to be named as author of cover art, but then you would be the owner/claimant with transfer 'by written agreement.'
- (3) COMMISSIONED WORK FOR HIRE. In this case, we are not talking about paying someone to create a work. Instead, it is a very specific scenario where there must be a written agreement, signed by both parties, that specifically identified the work as a 'work for hire.' It is very important that the written agreement specifically identifying as a work for hire signed by both parties exists, because then the legal author of the artwork is the hiring party (not the person who actually created the work.) This is different from the transfer in #2, in that the transfer only needs a writing, signed by the party giving away the copyright, with no mention of for hire."

I got the response from someone saying they do COMMISSION WORK FOR HIRE and just get an agreement from who they hired.

My problem is, the person I hired on Fiverr is no longer available on that platform and I have no way of contacting them to get an agreement to give me the copyright for my book cover that I paid her for. So I am just unsure how to go about this and respond to the copyright office and am looking for some assistance.

I have it that way because 1, most of the best seller books in this niche are this size, and 2, I would like it if I can somehow leave a small blank margin on the sides of the interior pages for people to be able to add their own notes while they are reading. Do you think that this is ok or should I just stick to 6x9? I could also do 7x9 with no margins. I really don't want to make any extra work for myself by using this size, but I just feel like books in this niche look better being a little more square.?
