





I'm reviewing the 30K manuscript (for the third time), written and edited by The Urban Writers, but I'm still finding sentences and paragraphs that sound a bit off. For example, they wrote:

"You may be under the impression that you are good enough to face every emergency once you have set up an emergency toolkit. But have you considered that your health emergency kit may not come in handy when faced with a blackout? It can be worrisome; however, you can deal with it simply by adopting flexibility that starts with acknowledging the changing nature of emergencies."

I ran this paragraph through ChatGPT and I got this:

This realization can be worrisome; however, you can address it by adopting flexibility, which starts with acknowledging the changing nature of emergencies."

My questions are, should I be asking them to fix all these paragraphs or should I just approve the manuscript and try to fix them myself? What are the pros and cons of doing this?
