



There are many students on this call, all at different points in their publishing journey. We receive many questions and do our best to choose the ones that are applicable and helpful to the majority of attendees on this call.


We would rather spend more time going deep into a good question rather than rushing from one question to the next. Therefore, we will pick and choose the best questions.



I'm having trouble getting the various programs [KDSpy, D.S. Amazon Quick View, Google Chrome and ChatGPT] to work together in harmony on my Mac [running Sonoma 14.2.1]. The KDSpy doesn't show the little key, and if I use it and then try to check a book as advised, when I try to return, it's gone and I have to find it and sometimes even log back into it. The ChatGPT can also be problematic as it doesn't stay on my desktop either-- often I have to find it and open it again and again. I NEED TO TALK TO A HUMAN BEING in TechSupport who knows Macs. Is there a help line number I can call? And if there is no one to help me, what am I suppose to do?
