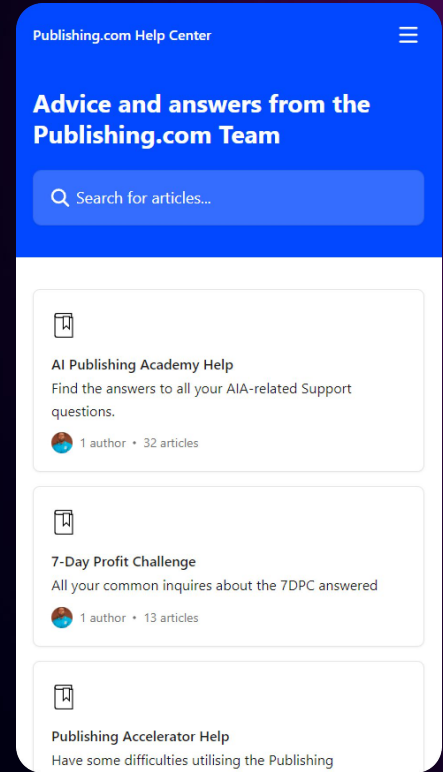

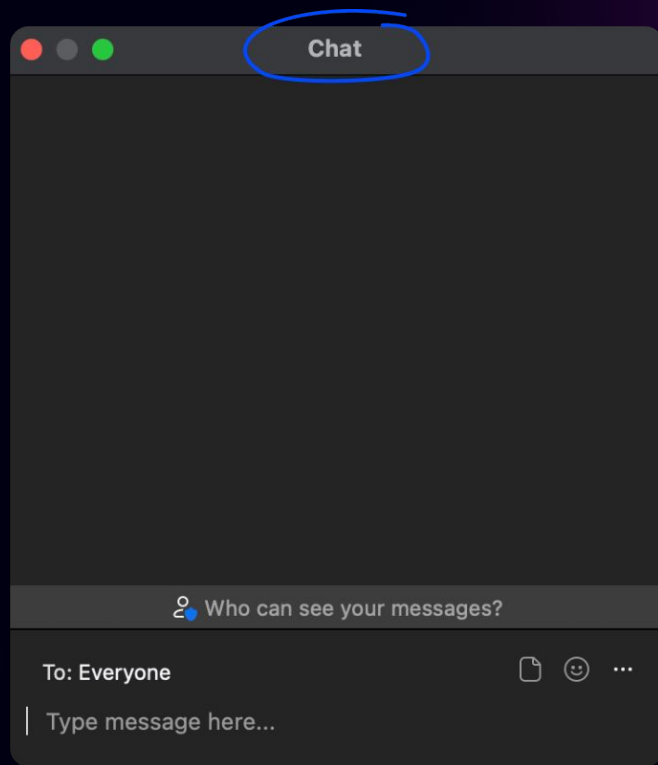

Reviews question. During the period when Amazon allowed my book to be listed for \$0.00, I received many verified purchase reviews through Pubby. However, since the free period ended and the price is now \$0.99, few Pubby reviewers are willing to leave verified purchase reviews.

The program advises aiming for 100 reviews, with as many verified purchase reviews as possible. Given the lack of interest in reviewing the \$0.99 book, around 40 of the 100 reviews will be unverified. How big of a problem is it if 60 of my reviews are verified and 40 are unverified?
