We would rather spend more time going deep into a good question rather than rushing from one question to the next. Therefore, we will pick and choose the best questions.

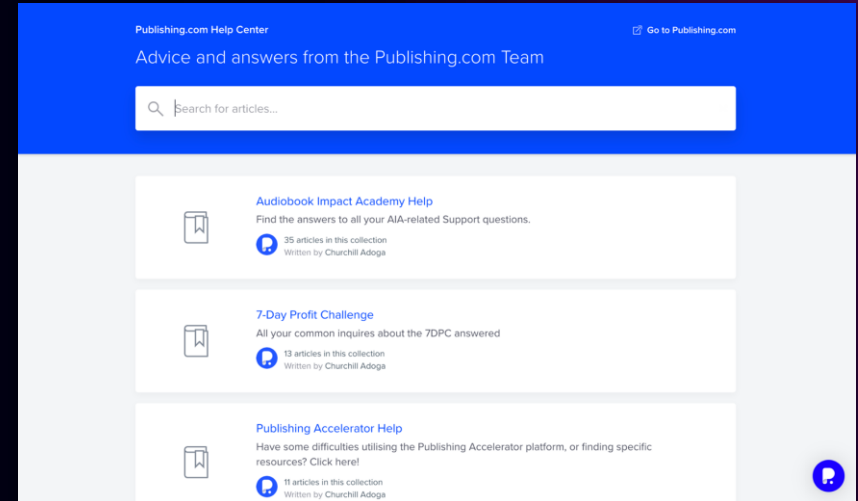

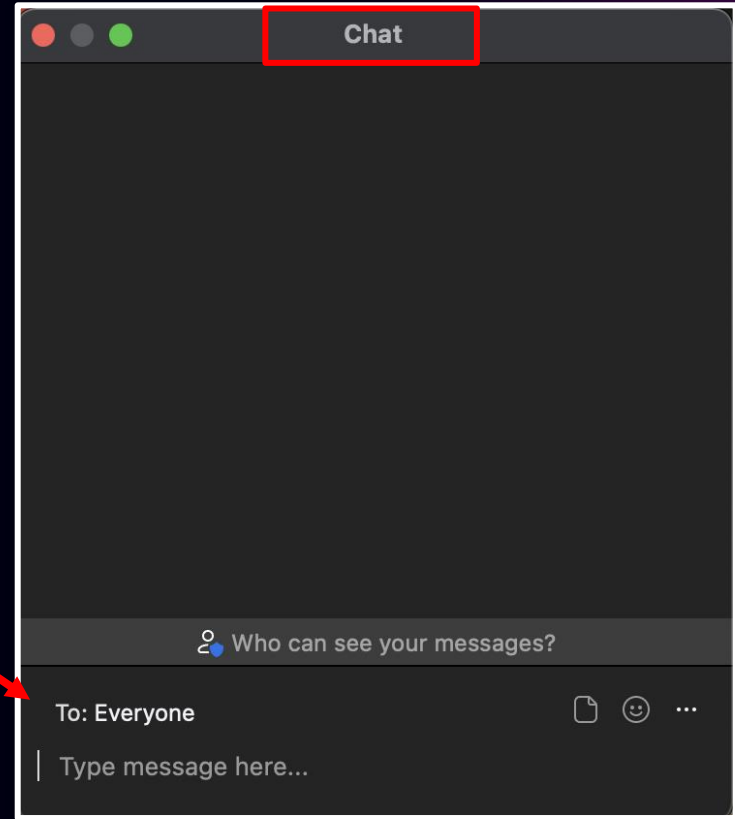

How do you keep motivated on your most difficult days?

I am in the formatting stage for my book on exercises for seniors. The WORD version of the book contains 265 pages. The book has quite a few exercises/illustrations, with each exercise starting on a new page, which drives up the page count. Also, there are about 50 pages in the Appendix that include various exercise routines. The maximum number of pages for my other top selling books in my niche is 187.

My question: I would like to make the font a larger size - size 16 - as the book is for seniors. This will, of course add even more pages. Is it better to have a more readable book, even though the page count will be considerably higher than the completion, or try to keep the page count as low as possible - to at least not be too much over the completion. Do you think there is a risk that the number of pages would make the book seem to complicated - even though the number of pages are actually for increased readability?

1st Question. I know that Amazon is very particular about the way author accounts are set up. I published my 7 day challenge book with KDP account set up using my personal Amazon Account. I have an LLC and at some point, want to set up my Publishing Business under it. I am close to uploading and launching my 1st 30K book. Would it be better to publish my first 30K book under my personal account, or try to set it up under my existing LLC?

2nd Question: Do you think there would be a problem using the same LLC for an Amazon reseller's business as well as my Publishing Business. My son would like to start an Amazon reseller's business and I am considering in being a "non-working" partner, but using my LLC for the reseller's business to run under. Have you had any experience with this? Is there a resource at Amazon or elsewhere that you know of, that can guide me through this?
