

We would rather spend more time going deep into a good question rather than rushing from one question to the next. Therefore, we will pick and choose the best questions.







Hi!!!! Can you please help me with my title: Crucial Life Skills for Teenagers: A Complete Guide To Build Self-Confidence and Become Independent and Responsible Individuals.

Is the Touch Paper review service recommended by AIA, and does it abide by KDP restrictions?

If we use ChatGPT to write content with minimal edits (and it passes all plagiarism checks), do we have to add AI disclaimers to our introduction? How about if we use Jasper.ai? OpenAI's publication policy says: "Creators who wish to publish their first-party written content (e.g., a book, compendium of short stories) created in part with the OpenAI API are permitted to do so under the following conditions:... The role of AI in formulating the content is clearly disclosed in a way that no reader could possibly miss, and that a typical reader would find sufficiently easy to understand."

When we write books for teens, are there issues with reaching out for reviews or DM-ing directly (since readers aren't adults)? And, for the FB review method, do authors usually join FB groups for parents or for teens?

By default, we publish our books in KDP with the 30% profit margin, but there's also a 70% option available in the publishing form. Should we use this after launch, or are there consequences?

Hi coaches, I'm close to running Amazon ads. In the Manual targeting lesson, Brian mentioned that book royalties may be low and example was \$4. My book royalty is lower so is it ok to start bid below \$.40?

I followed the modules and priced my book accordingly, but my book is almost 200 pages and the print cost wasn't pretty so my royalties cut down. Should I price book higher? I only used 1 free promo day and I have 15 ratings. Thoughts or advice? Thank you.
