We would rather spend more time going deep into a good question rather than rushing from one question to the next. Therefore, we will pick and choose the best questions.

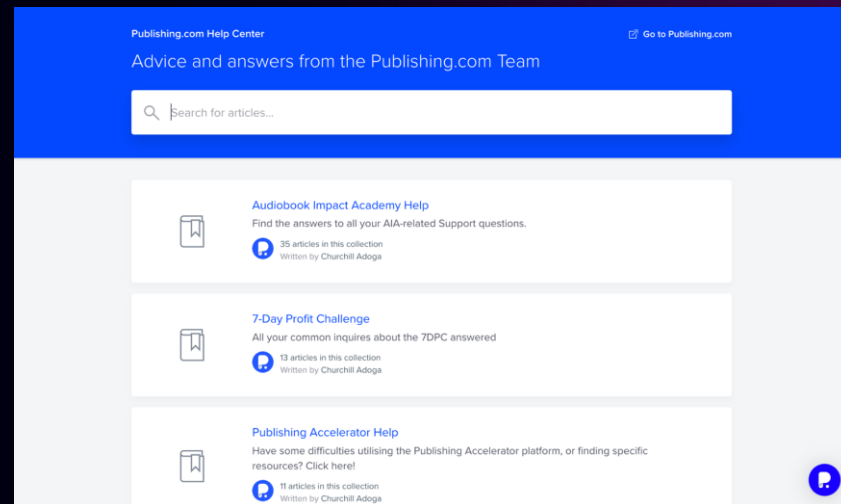

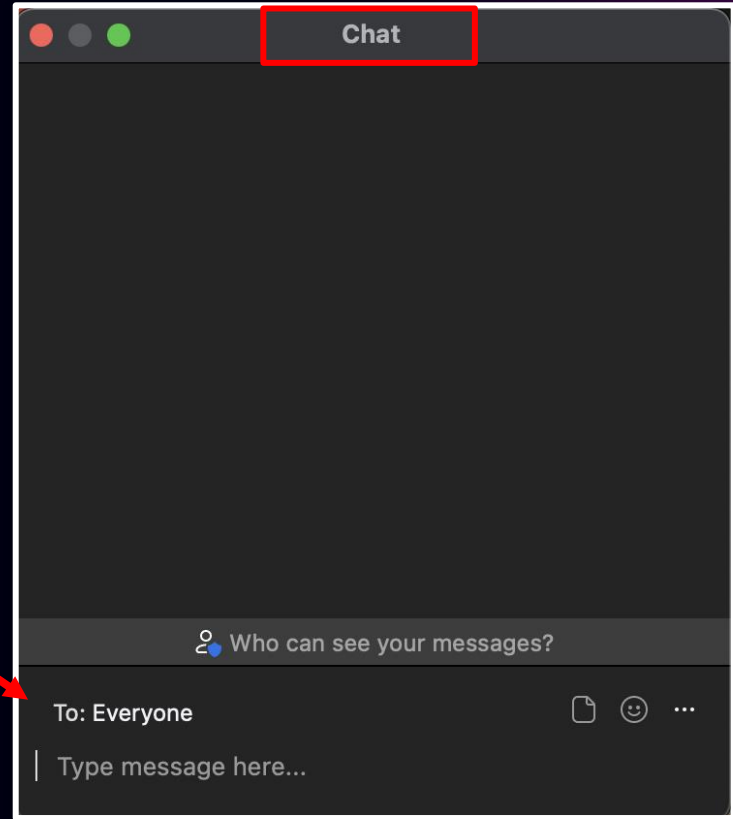

I have an amazing outline from Publishing Services, but now that my ghostwriter has finished the introduction, it's not what I'm looking for at all. Mostly, I've noticed the the writer makes a lot of assumptions about the reader and addresses those assumptions like they are facts. For example, writing in a way that assumes the reader is a millennial. Or writing about how the reader feels, not knowing if they actually feel a certain way. Just a lot of assumptions.

I've also noticed that they seem to be a bit defensive with my feedback. I am wondering if I need to work with someone else with more experience in ghost writing. Is it too early to tell since we are only in the introduction?
