



There are many students on this call, all at different points in their publishing journey. We receive many questions and do our best to choose the ones that are applicable and helpful to the majority of attendees on this call.


We would rather spend more time going deep into a good question rather than rushing from one question to the next. Therefore, we will pick and choose the best questions.

Is the way to find out if your book is INDEXED correctly (because Amazon ads are providing no impressions), to do the following: (1) Look up competitor books to see what's selling. (2) Identify which categories they are being ranked in down below in the PRODUCT DETAILS, (3) Make sure to cross check the various formats, like ebook vs paperback vs hardcover, to get a sense for where the competitors are placed, (4) Go into my KDP PLATFORM and change my 3 categories to reflect where my competition appears to be placing themselves?

For my clarity, is it always the case that the PRODUCT DETAIL Categories (that show #5 in XYZ category, etc) are always the categories that have been chosen inside the KDP PLATFORM?

After RE-INDEXING, (after changing my book categories), do I need to delete my ad campaigns and restart them from scratch? (In order to make sure that Amazon starts delivering my ads to the correct places?
