

Do I delete the origional TOC w/ the sub headings and then make one with just the chapter headings and pg numbers? How do I get it to be interactive? The instructions I got from KDP were to highlight the chapter titles and click on HOME PAGE. I am on a Chromebook and I do not see any HOME PAGE. (This is of course all being done in my google docs). And should the chapter headings be showing up in a blue color?
