


Welcome to the Publishing Family!

There are many students on this call, all at different points in their publishing journey. We receive many questions and do our best to choose the ones that are applicable and helpful to the majority of attendees on this call.


We would rather spend more time going deep into a good question rather than rushing from one question to the next. Therefore, we will pick and choose the best questions.



I've been running ads on my book since August and they were doing well, mostly around 30-40% ACOS. But since December my auto-high campaigns have skyrocketed and when I look at searches, they don't seem on point. I'm ending up having to negative target a lot of books that seem off, and there are little to no keywords. And that's happened in all 4 countries where I'm running ads to a degree but the worst performing one is on the US. Meanwhile my keywords campaigns are still working well. And many of those keywords were inspired thanks to the auto-high campaign in the first few months.

Is that something that happens after a while?

I'm tempted to stop the current auto-high and start again from scratch?

Could it be an indexing problem? I don't remember changing anything but maybe a less relevant

category became stronger.






Cover Intervention Submission Rules
