We would rather spend more time going deep into a good question rather than rushing from one question to the next. Therefore, we will pick and choose the best questions.

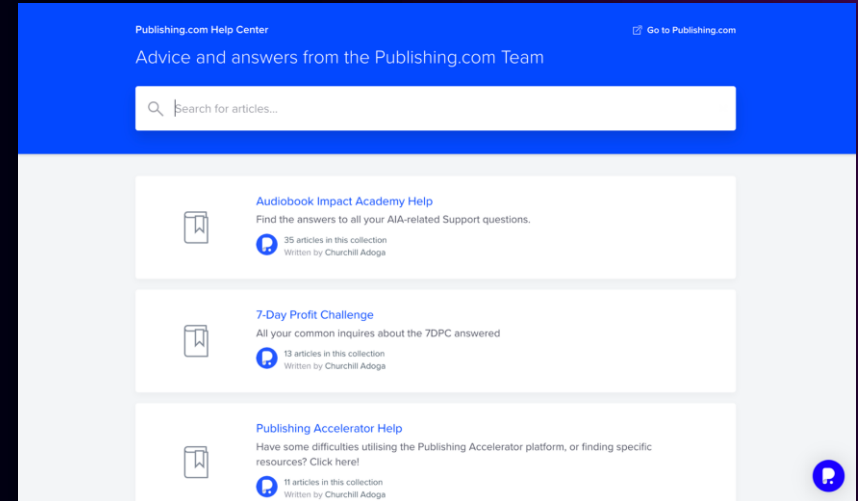

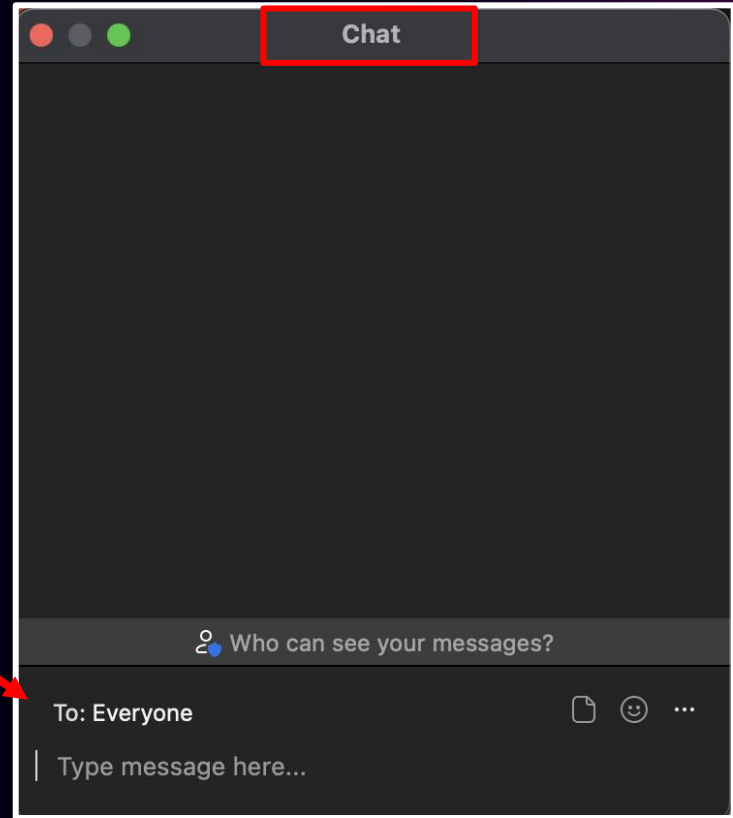

The first time I tried it, it gave me 6 chapters. When I ask it to re-do the outline and make it 10 chapters, it produces just 5 chapters and conclusion again. I've also tried to ask it to "Continue generating response" in case it didn't finish but it will just give me a conclusion after the 5 chapters. I've also tried "Regenerate response". Any ideas on what to do about this? Maybe it doesn't generate much content because it's a workout/exercise book? I plan to hire Publishing Services to do the outline anyway, but I at least wanted a good preliminary outline. Thank you!
