There are many students on this call, all at different points in their publishing journey. We receive many questions and do our best to choose the ones that are applicable and helpful to the majority of attendees on this call.

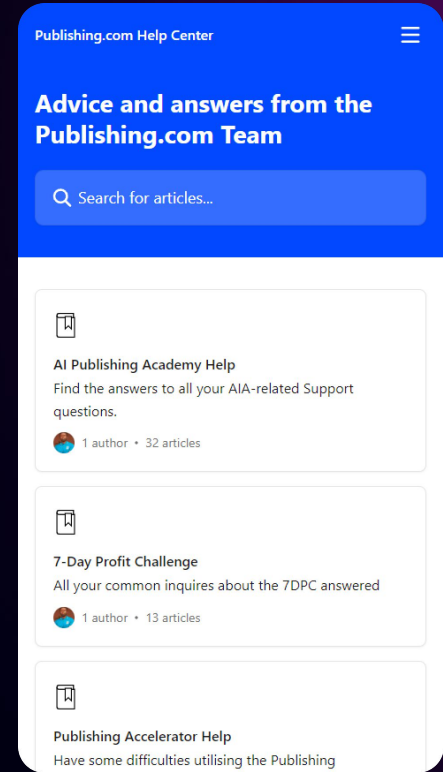
We would rather spend more time going deep into a good question rather than rushing from one question to the next. Therefore, we will pick and choose the best questions.



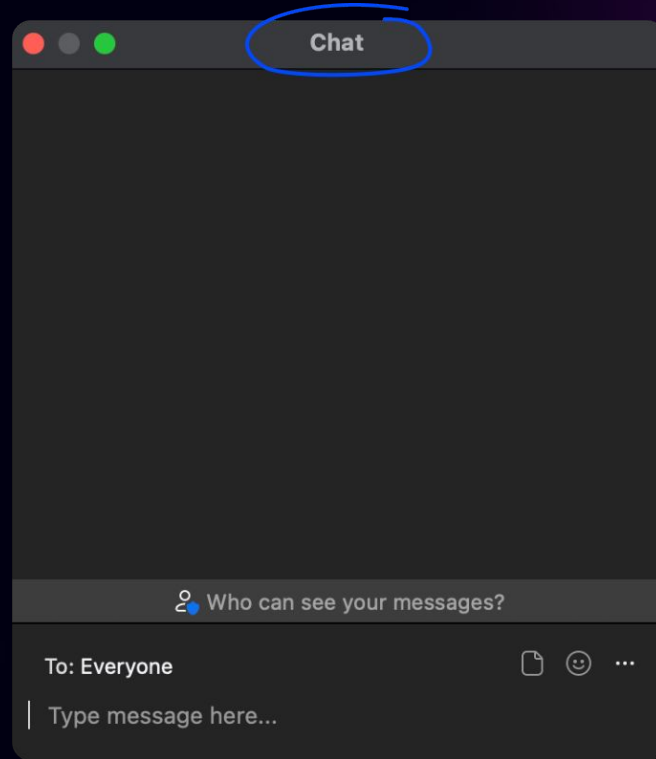

I just launched my 2nd book and my bundle this past week. I will be at 15 reviews for each by tomorrow. I know it takes time to get your ads to spend when you first launch them. How can I ramp up my ads as quickly as possible to take advantage of Black Friday and holiday shopping? My books are perfect for gifting. For my first book, I've been running ads at \$30 per campaign and increasing the bid spend at .05 cents every 3 days as instructed in the training, and they're spending and converting, but it's taken quite a few weeks to spend. Anything else I can do to get these 2 new ones (my 2nd book and my bundle) ramped quickly for holiday gifting? THANK YOU!

Hi Coaches, I'm working on outline. I have generated 7 outlines. The Publishing.ai generated outline looks very different from that of competitors' books for my topic, Somatic Exercises for Beginners.

Our AI-generated outlines look like they would have more descriptive chapters with paragraphs, whereas competitors have the exercise moves listed one after another on their table of contents and would have one or two pages of visuals and instructions inside for each move.

I don't know how the AI will write the manuscript in the end. Do I need to adjust and follow the structure of our competitors' books if our AI produces a manuscript that is too descriptive, not to the point or too different from the competitors'? Or should I just trust our AI's outline which could potentially be better and informative?
